## The 4<sup>th</sup> International Conference of Uranian Astrology from 6<sup>th</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> June in Hamburg/Germany

With this Congress we commemorate the 90th anniversary of Alfred Witte's official presentation of his new mathematically orientated research method in the "Kepler Zirkel" at Hamburg in 1919. Alfred Witte was at that time not a member of this community of traditional astrology, but his new ideas were the reason that this Group founded by Friedrich Siegrün and his student Ludwig Rudolph, was dissolved in order to follow Witte's new ways. New ways which resulted from the study of the ancient sources and consequent adaptation of mathematics.

We are part of this way and return with this Congress back to Hamburg, the city of origin, giving this method its name "Hamburg School".

Two languages are spoken on our Conference: 7 Lectures will be held in English, the language of Science of today. 4 lectures will be held in German, the language of Science in the days of Alfred Witte. You don't not need to understand both languages. Your Congress-Manual will include the language of your choice, German or English. Additional translations and translators are available during the presentations.

### Hamburg



The story of Hamburg started 1200 years ago, at the north of the franc empire, where the "brown river" *Alster* flows into the "white river" *Elbe*. The Alster flowed through a marsh, therefore the water was brown. In old-saxony language a "Ham" is the meaning for "a Land on the shore, marsh". Because of the marshland, settlements and refuges were set upon small hills ("hamme"). From such refuges a small fortress arose later. The *Hammaburg* was mentioned documentarily in 834. So we can say: The name of Hamburg means a refuge (burg) on a hill in the marshland at the shores of the river Elbe.

### What ist the IUF?



Today, a community of Friends with 100 associated Members worldwide. We honor the Uranian Alfred Witte, his methods, and the astrologers who followed him.

The International Uranian Fellowship was founded on the 20th May 2007 in The Hague, Netherlands, during the second International Congress of Uranian Astrology (Spirit, Soul and Body).

Udo Rudolph (1921-2008), President of the HSARC (Astrological Research Center of the Hamburg School), stimulated us for the search of a new name, which was found at 18:42 GMT (Long 4E17'57, Lat 52N05'10).

**Tiziana Ghirardini, Italy**

Lecture: *Neptune and the evolution of the species*

Tiziana is President of the “*Centro Astrologico*” in Bologna/Italy. She studied deeply well known top evolutionary astrologers like Jeff Green, T. Mann, A. Oken and R. Merriman. Some years ago she expanded towards healing energetic and vibrational techniques, working together with Anne Givaudan and Michel le Bruyere. Tiziana is researcher, teacher and organises 3 years classes, seminars and lectures. Tiziana and Lietta Catoni organised the 1st IUF-Conference (May 2006) in Bologna/Italy. Tiziana is core co-founder of the IUF.

**Penelope Bertucelli, USA**

presented by Brigitta Klose, Germany, co-worker and co-editor of the Journal “*Hamburger Hefte*”

Penelope, educated in journalism, has been committed to the Hamburg School methods of Alfred Witte and Ludwig Rudolph since the 1970's. She is/has been an astrologer and an astrology teacher, lecturer, publisher, writer, astrological conference organizer and co-founder of the IUF. Penelope made contact with Udo Rudolph in 1979. He became her mentor and teacher all these years. Penelope held Uranian conferences with Udo and other well known personalities such as Charles Emerson, Sylvia Sherman, Martha Wescott and John Jenkins. She is, in a close cooperation with Hamburg/Germany, Owner/founder of Penelope Publications (1985) and main distributor of Uranian publications in the English language, [www.uranianastrologer.com](http://www.uranianastrologer.com). She wrote, translates and publishes several books, e.g. the well known magazine “*Uranian Forum*” (1985-1992).

**Meira B. Epstein, USA**

Lecture: *The Annual Solar Return Chart and The Uranian System*

Meira is a professional certified astrologer (NCGR-IV). She is the Secretary of the Uranian Society in New York and a teacher and a speaker for the NCGR (National Council for Geocosmic Research) the biggest astrological Society in the USA. Meira has translated astrological books from the 12th century, written by Rabbi Ibn Ezra, from Hebrew into English. She found a common ground between the Lots of the ancient Hellenistic astrology and the sensitive points of the Witte astrology. **Michael Feist, Germany**

Lecture: *Calculate a Trans-Neptunian! A historical look back on Siegrün's work*

Michael's family practices Astrology since 95 years. He's one of seven family members, who were educated in Witte's Astrology. Michael starts his studies in 1982 as personal student of his Granny Emma Rudolph, and in addition as a student of his Uncle Udo Rudolph. Michael's main emphases are his studies of the astrological and historical development of the Uranian Astrology. At first known as a programmer, he became in the 1990s editor and publisher of the most important German Uranian Journal “*Hamburger Hefte*”, which he published in his own Publishing House “*Edition Astrologic*”. Since 2005, Michael leads the Witte's Publishing House ([www.Witte-Verlag.com](http://www.Witte-Verlag.com)). He's core co-founder of the IUF.

**Nona Gwynn Press, USA**

Lecture: *The Uranian Planets, and Personal Name Asteroids, of President Obama.*

Nona is President of the National Council for Geocosmic Research (NCGR) Asteroid Special Interest Group and editor of its newsletter GAIA, was President of the Uranian Society SIG (1993-2004) and Research Chairman of the NCGR New York Chapter for 8 years. Nona is one of Dr. Geoffrey Dean's collaborators on “*Recent Advances in Natal Astrology*” and author of the book, “*New Insights into Astrology*”, and booklet, “*Personal Name Asteroids*”. She has lectured for many astrological associations: NCGR, AFA, ISAR, Uranian Society, NY Astrology Center and NY Open Center, as well as the 1st International Conference of Uranian Astrology. A member of Phi Beta Kappa, she holds a B.A. in Art History from Columbia University. Nona is co-founder of the IUF.

**Dott.ssa Lietta Catoni, Italy**

Lecture: *Personality disorders part 2 : from the patient to the psycho-therapist*

First Udo Rudolph's personal student and later his co-worker on three newsletters "Hamburg Leaves", in 2005. Lietta attained a diploma of the Hamburg School Association and co-organized the first meeting of Uranian Astrology, in Bologna 2006 - the cradle of all IUF conferences. She's IUF core co-founder and member of the Uranian Society (New York) and NCGR. Lietta represents Witte's Astrology in Italy as consultant and teacher. She published in the weekly magazine "A" edited by Rizzoli - "Corriere della Sera" (Milano) and on [www.uraniana.it](http://www.uraniana.it). For her researches of personality disorders, she collaborates with a psychotherapist. Lietta held lectures in New York and several European cities. She's graduated in Economy and has taught Economy for many years.

**Francine Rasenberg, Netherlands**

Lecture: *The key to the Black Moon's potential and what makes the difference to unlock it as explained by the Hamburg School Astrology*

Francine is Secretary of the WKO, a Dutch Astrological Research Group which practices and propagates the Ebertin-Cosmobiology and the Hamburg School Astrology. Additionally she deepened her astrological knowledge with the transpersonal Black Lights astrology of Carteret. Francine has lectured Uranian Astrology in Holland, Italy, Letland and New York for the 25th anniversary of the Uranian Society. She is co-founder of the IUF and member of the Uranian Society (New York) and NCGR. Francine has organised the 2nd IUF-Conference (May 2007) in The Hague, Holland.

**Dr. Christoph Schubert-Weller, Germany**

Born 1950, studies in philosophy, germanics, linguistics and education, astrology since 1976, chairman of the German Astrologers' Association since 2005.

**Liane Thomas Wade, USA**

Lecture: *China, After the Olympics, her place in the world - mundane astrology in the Uranian System.*

Liane has been a student of astrology for over 20 years. She is President of the Uranian Society, and is the Executive Secretary of NCGR (National Council of Geocosmic Research). She lectured at NCGR Conferences in New York City, at the NCGR National Conference in Baltimore in 2007, at UAC in Denver in 2008 where she was the Track Co-ordinator for the Uranian Track, in Bologna, Italy at the First International Uranian Conference, and at the Irish Astrological Association. She has written for "The Ingress", the "memberletter", and "The Urania Journal", often on political topics. Liane is co-founder of the IUF.

**Karsten Ferdinand Kröncke, Germany**

Karsten F. Kröncke, born in Hamburg, was until 1973 management assistant of a Hamburg Coffee trade company (Pils Kaffee). He started his astrology studies with the method of Hamburg School (Uranian Astrology), in summer 1970. Karsten F. Kröncke was personal student of Hermann Lefeldt. He keeps, spreads and teaches Hermann Lefeldt's special principles, as hardly no-one else, and is a good expert of Witte's Astrology. Since 1973 he works as an astrological enterprise adviser. In the same year Karsten founded the "Institute for Astrology" - Free study group for teaching and research, in Freiburg/Breisgau. Arose from it "Kulturgut Astrologie e.V."
